Instruction for sheep blood collection



Make a small cut about ½ cm into the bottom edge or tip of the ear of the sheep using electrical sidecutters.




Clean the sidecutters in a large amount of water if they are contaminated with blood from previous animals.

Collect blood from the cut onto the strips on the collection cards. Ensure blood soaks through.



One card has SIX collection strips and each strip is for one sample.

3 Label the each strip clearly with a unique ID (e.g. a brass tag number and year) for each blood spot. WRITE YOUR NAME ON FACH CARD.



Blood samples are air-dried and then can be easily posted (together with a current New Zealand Ministry for Primary Industries import permit if from overseas) to the following address:
